The indicators of health depends much more on the other factors like drinking water, literacy, nutrition, sanitation and much more on the status of the women in the society and women empowerment policies of the governance.

Apart from this the investment and infrastructure in health sectors are the important aspects.


The society from August 2021- Dec 2021 has undertaken the health survey of the Village of Sahapur, Block Belaganj, Gaya on the suggestion of the Governing Board Member Dr. Jyoti Bindal with an objective to identify the health status of the village along with ascertaining the felt and perceived needs of the habitant of the village.

The Health survey was conducted by a team of social scientist in consultation with the medical professionals. The project was planned and adopted on a logical framework approach. The operational mechanism of the research-project, maintaining absolute adherence to the Project Evaluation Review Technique (PERT) methodology were maintained. The anthropological research method and traditional techniques of data collection were considered. The field work concluded in the month of December 2021.

Though it is was micro study yet the recommendation on the basis of data in hand, a suggestions for a Holistic integrated approach can be arrived.





The Champaran Satyagrah impacted the contemporary politics and the society and charged them with the idea of non violence "AHIMSA", a new way of getting freedom.

The objective of the audio video documentary is to promote the Gandhian Ideology and to look into these folksongs for the influence that Gandhi had on the folk minds during the time of India's struggle for independence.


