



Folksongs are oral tradition transmitted through social interaction via indigenous dialect which exist in the memories and voices of living individuals.


They primarily shares common bodies of knowledge, value systems, ideologies i.e. the lore, traditional knowledge and beliefs of cultures.


Like the written literature they contain both prose and verse narratives in addition to myths, dramas, rituals etc. All the cultures have their own folk songs.





India will bring its non-fossil energy capacity to 500 GW by 2030; its economy's carbon intensity down to 45 per cent by 2030.

The country will fulfil 50 per cent of its energy requirement through renewable energy by 2030 and will reduce one billion tonnes of carbon emissions from the total projected emissions by 2030 and will achieve Net Zero by 2070.



थैले बना कर गांवों की 800 महिलाएं बन रहीं आत्मनिर्भर

सोसाइटी फॉर इंपावरमेंट की ओर से कस्तरबा गांधी सेंटर फॉर टेनिंग व प्रोडक्शन की शरुआत की गयी है. इसके तहत गांवों की महिलाओं को स्वावलंबी और सशक्त करने के लिए सिलाई का प्रशिक्षण दिया जा रहा है. गया जिले के बेलागंज प्रखंड के शाहपुर में इसकी शुरुआत की गयी है. इसका मकसद महिलाओं को आत्मनिर्भर बना कर रोजगार से जोड़ना है. संस्था से यहां नौ गांवों से कुल 800 महिलाएं व युवतियां जुड़ी हुई हैं, जो दो शिफ्टों में काम कर रही हैं. ये सभी महिलाएं अभी कपड़े के थैले और मास्क बनाने का काम कर रही हैं.

खादी मॉल से मिला है थैले बनाने का ऑर्डर

संस्था के डायरेक्टर एस नारायण ने बताया कि उनकी संस्था गांधी के विजन के साथ काम करती है. अभी उनका टाइअप खादी ग्राम उद्योग, खादी मॉल और नीति आयोग से रजिस्टर्ड संस्थाओं से हुआ है. हाल ही में खादी मॉल से 10000 थैले बनाने का ऑर्डर मिला है, जिसे इन गावों की महिलाएं तैयार कर रही हैं. उनकी कोशिश होती है कि जो भी ऑर्डर मिले, वह सरकार के सौजन्य से हो. वहीं प्राइवेट कंपनियों के ऑर्डर को लेकर काम जल्द शुरू किया जायेगा. इसके साथ ही संस्था की ओर से ओपन स्कूल सिस्टम के एक्रेडेशन के लिए अप्लाइ किया गया है. इससे जो भी महिलाएं यहां पर प्रशिक्षण लेंगी, उन्हें ओपन स्कूल का सर्टिफिकेट दिया जायेगा. जिससे उन्हें आगे भी रोजगार का मौका मिलेगा.

समय-समय पर दिया जाता है प्रशिक्षण

गांव में रहनेवाली महिलाओं को सिलाई का बेसिक ज्ञान होता है. ऐसे में प्रोफेशनल बनाने के लिए उन्हें संस्था की ओर से समय—समय पर प्रशिक्षकों की ओर से प्रशिक्षण दिया जाता है. इससे वे न सिर्फ अपने हुनर को निखारती हैं, बल्कि ऑर्डर के अनुसार उत्पादों का निर्माण भी करती हैं. अभी जिस तरह से कोरोना के मामले घीरे—घीरे बढ़े हैं, ऐसे में महिलाएं मास्क भी तैयार कर रही हैं. एस नारायण ने बताया कि महिलाओं की ओर से बनाये जाने वाले मास्क वहीं के सरकारी और प्राइवेट संस्था के लोग खरीद लेते हैं.

की ओर से कोर्स सर्टिफिकेट सिलाई की ट्रेनिंग दी जाती है. सोसाइटी दिया जायेगा.गया स्थित शाहपुर में भी एक सेंटर चलाया जा रहा है, जिसमें 65 महिलाएं प्रशिक्षित हो रही हैं.



दो बैच में महिलाएं सीखती हैं सिलाई: इंद्रपुरी के आस–पास रहने वाली महिलाएं इस सेंटर में आकर ट्रेनर की मदद से प्रशिक्षण लेती हैं . अप्रैल से शुरु हुए इस सेंटर में दो बैच में दोपहर दो बजे से लेकर शाम छह बजे तक 30 महिलाएं प्रशिक्षत हो रही हैं . सोसाइटी फॉर इंपावर मेंट की सेकेटरी डॉ शिवानी ने बताया कि हमारी पूरी कोशिश है कि इन महिलाओं को एक प्लेटफॉर्म मिले जहाँ वे अपने उत्पादों को बेच कर आर्थिक तौर पर आत्मनिर्भर हो सकें.



मैंने 2009 में सिलाई की टेनिंग ली थी. इस सेंटर के बारे में मुझे पड़ोस में रहने वाली महिला सें पता चला . शुरुआत में न्यूज पेपर पर कटिंग करना सिखायाँ गया और अब डायरेक्ट मैं कपड़े पर

कटाई खुद से कर पाती हूं और सिलाई भी कर पाती हूं.

The interns are assigned a supervisor who supervises and assigns the task as per requirement. On completion of the internship, the intern are being provided certificate, as per performance of the intern.



Indians have traditionally relied on family support in post-retirement years — a phenomenon termed as pillar zero in the World Bank's five-pillar pension framework.
