Traditional Tribal Therapy

To start with, Viruses, Bacteria does not discriminate humans on race, sex, religion etc. they attack on the health of humans and only shield is the moral ethics in the form of health hygiene, life style values, social values and survival instinct.

It is interesting to note that the Covid pandemic an urban creation has taking life of the humans in the progressive society / modern society, however, still major portion of the rural and especially the remote areas have been protected from the pandemic. A lot may be said; that they were cut off or are having restricted movements/interaction; still it was observed that the nature and the terrain and also timely government, social and local interventions have made them immunized from this major health aberration.

As Albert Einstein pointed out: "We cannot solve our problems with the same thinking we used when we created them", it can be said that time has come when reemphasizing the Gandhian Value in social and economic life is required, as can be seen by it's widely prevalence in the tribal and rural India. This needs to be reemphasized, quantified and qualified today.

The traditional health resource of herbal medicine is a great health immunity to the tribals. The seasonal viral, bacterial, fungal and nutrient deficiency is natively tackle by the Baigas (Vaidya) in the tribal areas. The acceptance of the herbopathy and naturopathy is to be promoted outside the tribal world by incorporating the importance of nature and trees in the primary/middle/higher secondary education system.

A few of the details of the herbal medicine, to treat the common ailments in tribal area are as under:

- Malaria Treatment: Malarial attacks are prevalent in a tropical climate. An interesting thing is that the tribal treat Malaria with a) the help of red ants which is found on trees. The red ants nest is collected and dropped on the patient body to bite. The patient head and ears are covered with clothes. Thereafter sometime the red ants are removed from the body of patients. The patient is left to rest for a gradual recovery.
- b) Fever: The common medicine for generations in treatment of fever is taking chutney made of red ants, ginger, garlic, coriander and chilli.
- c) Body Immunity: Chhapra, a paste made from red ants, is a traditional delicacy in Bastar, increases the body immunity.
- d) Kaddha: t is prepared in similar to what generally is prepared in the heartlands but the composition of the Tribal Khadha are more enriched and also provides superior immunity. The list of the herbs/plant in preparing KADHA is as follows: .3

Method to Prepare the Drink

Take 100 gram of each and boil it in 7 liter fresh drinking water on low flame till it become half liter then in the morning sip it like tea for 2 or 3 days and it will work in the body as preventive and curative medicine.

It has emerged that tribals traditional knowledge, folklore, folk tales, folk songs, folk riddles, world view, ethos etc. are full of teaching and preaching to lead a healthy life normal life. There are several roots, fruits, herbs, leaves etc. to cure disease and to help the tribals to lead a normal healthy life. We all should endeavor that the remaining Population of the State may also Learn the Traditional Tribal Therapy with the help of such Herbs, Roots, Fruits, for which an awareness programme may also be commissioned in the interest of the state by the tribal leadership in the field of traditional knowledge of health.

LYCHEE IS A TROPICAL FRUIT with an excellent source of vitamin C and antioxidants.

Lychees "Litchi chinensis", has been grown in tropical and sub-tropical regions since 2000 BC according to records in China. Lychee fruits have a tough inedible skin that is red or pink when ripe. The pale edible flesh inside surrounds an inedible brown seed.

Nutrient Value of Lychee

Fresh whole lychee contains a total 72 mg of vitamin C per 100 g of fruit, an amount representing 86% of the daily value (DV).

On an average, consuming nine peeled lychee fruits will meet an adult's daily vitamin C requirement. A 100 g serving of raw lychee fruit provides, among other dietary minerals in minor amounts, 7% copper, 4% phosphorus, and 4% potassium (for DV in a 2,000-calorie diet). Lychees are low in saturated fat and sodium

Finance Topic

SCSS is a central government-backed savings scheme. It is a full debt instrument with zero risks. Valid for those above 60 years of age, it gives the security of assured income for the entire tenure of investment.

This investment plan for senior citizens is only for Indians aged 60 years and above. The only exception in age criteria are citizens who opt for the Voluntary Retirement Scheme (VRS) or Superannuation while they are 55-60 years of age or retired defence personnel between 50 and 60 years of age.

The current interest rate offered by this senior citizen scheme is 8.20%@. These rates are reviewed every quarter, with the last review being March 31, 2023. This new rate applies solely to new deposits from that date, not to already existing ones. While SCSS rates of interest are open to being revised every quarter, these changes will not apply to already-enrolled investors. New rates of interest only apply to newer investors of a particular quarter.

The maximum investment amount in SCSS is Rs. 30 Lakh lump sum amount individually or the total investment cannot exceed Rs. 30 Lakh across all your accounts in this scheme. Interest is service on a quarterly basis, after your first investment. The payouts from this senior citizen scheme are made on the first dates of April, July, October, and January – as per your date of investment.

Maximum tenure of the Senior Citizen Saving Scheme is 5 years. After this, you can extend it for 3 more years. This is a one-time option. What must be noted is that upon extension, the interest rates applicable at that particular quarter would apply.

SCSS accounts can be prematurely closed (or foreclosed) at any desired time – but one year after account opening. This is therefore not a short-term deposit. If you close the account before completing 2 years, 1.5% of the deposited amount will be deducted as a penalty. If account closure is after 2 years, 1% of the deposited amount is levied as a penalty. For 3-year extended accounts (after the 5-year maturity mark) you can close your account after the first year without any penalty being applied. SCSS account is also transferable anywhere in India.

Investment under this scheme qualifies for the benefit of section 80C of Income Tax Act, 1961 & interest income is taxed as per your income-tax slab. Moreover, if the interest income you receive from this senior citizen's investment plan exceeds Rs.50,000 in a financial year, Tax Deducted at Source also applies. @Subject to prevailing rate




